Singer Code of Conduct:

- 1. Hotel rooms must remain locked at all times. Do not prop doors open.
- 2. Each individual is responsible for his/her own personal possessions. Angelica Cantanti Youth Choirs will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Do not bring valuables. For lost items contact the hotel directly.
- 3. Singers shall not order any paid TV movies, shows, etc. Singers shall not charge any hotel services to their room.
- 4. No singer will leave the hotel or any rehearsal unless accompanied by an adult chaperone. Curfew will occur at 11:00pm (or another time designated by chaperones) and lights out at 11:30pm.
- 5. Boys are not allowed in girls' rooms; girls are not allowed in boys' rooms. If an exception is made, an adult chaperone must be present in the room the entire time there is mixed gender socialization.
- 6. Possession or use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or controlled substances (drugs or other illegal materials) will not be tolerated! Local authorities will be contacted. You will be asked to return home at your own expense.
- 7. Prompt attendance at all rehearsals and the performance is mandatory. Tardiness to a rehearsal or failure to attend a rehearsal will result in the singer either not being able to perform at the Orchestra Hall concert on Sunday, May 24, 2015 or other consequences deemed appropriate by Philip Brown.
- 8. Please keep revealing clothes (short shorts, halter tops, spaghetti straps, bare midriff, saggy pants, etc.) at home.
- Due to copyright/privacy issues permission is not granted to record any portion of the rehearsals or concert at the Chicago Orchestra Hall nor post any videos, photos or recordings on Facebook, YouTube, or any other social networking site.
- 10. Singers will not leave the Angelica Cantanti Youth Choirs group with strangers or non-choir singers. Any social activities with individuals outside of the Angelica organization must occur with a chaperone present.
